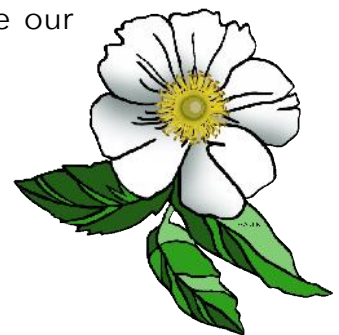

Hi all! Just a brief update I thought I would share. On November 17, 2021 my husband Matt and I welcomed our first baby, Dean Robert Dowd. He is named Dean after my grandmother, O'Deane, who passed away in October 2021 and Robert after my father who passed away in 2013.

He arrived 11 weeks early! His due date was originally February 1, 2022. He was quite a surprise! My water simply broke early. We arrived at the hospital around 10pm on 11/16 and he was welcomed to the world at 1:45am on 11/17. Clearly he was just ready! He was an overachiever from the start.
